Maria Beatrice Deli is Founding Partner of DeliSasson, Rome-Milan. She is Professor of International Law currently serving at the Universitas Mercatorum in Rome. Her areas of expertise include international commercial and investment arbitration law and complex litigation, acting as counsel and arbitrator. As counsel, Professor Deli spent 15 years in the international department of a major Italian law firm, where she gained extensive experience with foreign-based clients in a wide range of commercial disputes across a variety of industries. She initially gained arbitral tribunal experience by serving as the administrative secretary to tribunals in complex international cases, and she now acts as sole arbitrator, co-arbitrator, and tribunal chair in arbitral proceedings, both *ad hoc* and institutional, with seats in various countries.

In 2011 Maria Beatrice was appointed Secretary General of the Italian Association for Arbitration (AIA-Associazione Italiana per l'Arbitrato), overseeing the promotion of the institution in Italy and abroad. She is Chair of the ICC Italy Commission on Arbitration and ADR. From 2013 to 2021 she was Secretary General of ICC Italy. From April 2016 to March 2021, she was a member of the Council of the Milan Chamber of National and International Arbitration.

Maria Beatrice is member of the Anti-Doping National Court of Appeal.

Maria Beatrice is also member of various international associations on arbitration, like Club Espanol e Iberoamericano del Arbitraje, Arbitral Women, ICCA, a Founding member of Arblt (Italian Forum on International Arbitration and ADR) and member of the ICC World Business Institute.
